













## QUESTIONS FOR DISAPPEARING DESTINATIONS RESEARCH

-  What events, actions, or factors have repeated themselves?
-  What do we still want to know about this place?
-  What rules of nature are found at this place? How is the habitat structured?
-  What dilemmas or controversies are associated with this place?
-  How has this "Disappearing Destination" changed over time?
-  What are the opposing viewpoints from this place?
-  What do environmentalists and scientists see as the solution to saving this place from peril?
-  What groups will be affected if this place is not preserved? What disciplines would be impacted (e.g., tourism, economics, environment, politics, etc.)?
-  What are the origins of this place (e.g. formation, history, etc.)?
