If the child does not match most of the characteristics in the gifted column, perhaps wait until next year to test in order to allow the child some time to mature academically and/or behaviorally.

\*Test results are usually expected to return to the campuses approximately 8 weeks after the close of the testing session window.

\*The Campus Selection Committee then has to meet as a group to analyze the results and make identification decisions once the test results are returned to the campuses.

\*Please note... results may take longer to return if the testing window closes prior to a major holiday.
